

## CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE/DISMISSAL POLICY

The Challenger Learning Center of Maine strives to give all campers a positive and inspiring educational experience while they are at the Center. To achieve this goal, we provide a friendly and caring environment where campers can have a highly rewarding experience.

Mutual respect between campers and the Challenger staff is expected at all times, along with a positive attitude and enthusiastic participation. Similarly, campers are expected to be respectful of the Challenger facility, property and equipment.

Challenger will not tolerate offensive language, verbal or physical aggression, vandalism, or any situation that could result in harm to anyone. We reserve the right to remove campers from camp for the day and send them home, or bar them from camp altogether, in which case no refunds or credits will be issued for the day/week for which the camp reservation was made.

If a discipline problem should arise during camp, the camper will be given sufficient warning concerning any unacceptable behavior. If necessary, they may be removed from an activity. If problems persist, the camper may be sent home.\*

\*If attempts to call the parent or caregiver at the contact numbers provided are not responded to, we reserve the right to bar the camper from participating in any future Challenger camp.
